James Davis was a small man, in the War of 1812, and he was born in Virginia. James owned a plantation in Hawkins County, Tennessee, near Rogersville; during the early years of his life he lived on Cloud's Creek; later he moved across Clinch Mountain and lived in Mountain Valley, near Friendship, the remainder of his life. At least four of his brothers were also farmers and lived near Rogersville, Tennessee, in Hawkins County. James killed John Flowers of Hawkins County. This coincides with a record in the Circuit Court files in Hawkins County that says that in April 1816, James Davis, an older brother of Hezekiah II, killed John Flowers. John and James were good friends; they were at a community gathering. John Flowers got too much liquor "under his belt"; he became aggressive; he threatened James with a knife. James was backed into a picket fence with no further way of avoiding an encounter; he jerked a picket of f the fence and struck John. This resulted in John's death. James was acquitted of murder but the event caused him to leave the Choptack community. He, therefore, moved across the Clinch Mountains, settled near Friendship, and lived in Mountain Valley the rest of his days.

Will of James Davis (made 1866, proven February 10, 1868):

"In the name of God, Amen, I James Davis of the County of Hawkins and the State of Tennessee (Blessed be God) being in perfect and disposing mind and memory do this 21st day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six make this my last will and testament in the manner following:

"First, I give and bequeath to my four sons namely Madison, Asa, John and George Wesley, the tract of land upon which I now live to have to hold forever and to be equally divided between them share and share alike and my said sons Madison, Asa, John, and George Wesley for and in consideration of which they are to pay four hundred dollars to my other four children namely Nancy and her heirs James and Minerva one hundred, James and his heirs Eliza Ruth, Tildy Ann, George Lafayette, and Amanda one hundred dollars, Larkin and his heirs, Henry, Laner (Leanna), Mary, James, and Larkin one hundred dollars and Malinda and her heirs one hundred dollars.

"Second, it is my will and wish that the share to be allotted to my son Asa is to be laid off adjoining lands of my said son Asa on the west of my land and with a line parallel to his land.

"Third, it is my will and wish that the share to be allotted to my son George Wesley is to be laid off on the east end of my land in order to join the lands of my said son George Wesley and to begin at a point where the Spring branch crosses my line that runs from the farm which my son George Wesley purchased from Rial Johns thence down the branch to its junction with the creek, thence up or down said creek so that a straight line to the top of Copper Ridge will include his compliment.

"Fourth, I give and bequeath to my grandson Cornelius Davis my sorrel colt to have and to hold as his property.

"Fifth, I give and bequeath the balance of my property to my sons and daughters to be equally divided between them.

I'm looking for the ancestors of Abraham Adams. He was born in about 1730, possibly in the Northern Neck of VA. His brothers were John, Isaac, Daniel, and Jacob. (Isaac had a son named Abraham who was born in 1767.) He had some sisters, but their names aren't known. It certainly is possible that your John is the brother of my Abraham, but I don't know enough about him to say for certain. While I've been able to locate descendants of Abraham and his brothers, Isaac and Daniel, I've not found any descendants of his brother John. The mother of Abraham and siblings was named Elizabeth (maiden name unknown). There are some who say that their father was named John. This is based on the fact that there was a John Adams who died in the 1740s in Fairfax County, VA, whose wife was named Elizabeth--not a very strong argument, if you ask me.

In addition to my Adams family, there were at least two other Adams families in the Fauquier/Loudoun County area at the time that my Abraham was living there (c1760). One was from Charles County, MD (and still had connections there in the 1760s). This family appears to have been fairly prominent and has been fairly well documented. The second family is that of Absolem Adams. Descendants of Absolem report that it is possible that they are related to the Presidents Adams. They have not been able to prove this yet (so far as I know, anyway). My Adams ancestors MAY be related to the family of Absolem Adams (no real proof, but there are lots of similarities shared by the two families), but it is doubtful that they are related to the Charles County Adams.

In addition to the families mentioned above, there was reportedly another Adams family in Fairfax County. It also claims the John Adams who died in the 1740s in Fairfax County. In the genealogy that I've seen, it appears to overlap the family from Charles County, MD (that is, it claims some of the same people), but it isn't the same family. This family, by the way, was reportedly from Stafford County, VA (one of the reasons that I say that it isn't the same family as the one from Charles County, MD).

Unfortunately for you, all of the families I've mentioned were heavy users of the given name John.

Bottom line: I don't know if your John is a member of my Adams family, and if he isn't, I don't which Adams family he belongs to (there are so many to choose from). Sorry I can't be more positive or definitive.
